On July 1st, J.P. Mascaro & Sons will begin one of its largest, and most challenging, contracts - the Philadelphia School District. We were awarded the five-year contract on June 16th.

The Philadelphia School District is the eighth largest school district in the country and has approximately 200,000 students.

Our Souderton Division will be servicing the school district at the locations where there are front-load, roll-offs and compactors and the Bridgeport Division will be servicing those tighter areas that require rearload containers. Souderton has been very busy delivering over 400 containers – including front-load, over 40 rear-load, over 40 open top rolloffs, as well as low-profile, self-contained compactors to the more than 300 locations in the district. Luckily, they have gotten help from the Allentown, Bridgeport, Berks and Nanticoke divisions in getting the deliveries accomplished. Souderton's John Bush will be the Quality Control Supervisor for this contract.

In addition to providing waste removal, we will also be performing waste system audits at each of the district's locations in an effort to help the district improve the economy and efficiency of their waste management system. The company will also bring our Respect Program to the appropriate schools.

According to Pat Mascaro, Sr. "Our company worked diligently to earn this contract and the recommendation by the District's Evaluation Team and the contract award itself by the Commission are extremely gratifying. To me, it is a recognition of the outstanding dedication and commitment of Mascaro management employees making the necessary effort to secure a contract of this magnitude. Our service reputation and commitment won this contract and we look forward to serving the School District for years to come."
