J.P. Mascaro & Sons: Employee of the Month, White Pines Landfill, Amy Stugart, Office Manager and Scalemaster

Amy is a tremendous asset to our White Pines facility. With Mat being unavailable and having a very inexperienced Ops. Manager, she has risen to the occasion; she has essentially been running the place from a compliance perspective and has been doing a

great job. With the influx of drill cuttings over the past few months she has handled the extra work load and has not made one complaint about it. She does a great job with scheduling the cuttings with the transporters and communicates very effectively with me and everyone she is in contact with. From a compliance standpoint. Amy has gone above and beyond her call of duty. White Pines is currently without its. As a result, and in order to keep the facility running in a compliant manner. Amy has had to take on many additional roles - and she has done this without being asked. She ensures that daily compliance checklists are completed and sent to the ECD as required, and that all ECD Inspection recommendations are carried out in a timely manner. She also ensures that the waste acceptance program is adhered to and she keeps the ECD informed of any issues with regard to the drill cutting waste that is coming in. She never hesitates to call the ECD if there is something that she cannot

resolve. Additionally, she has been scanning every truck by hand to monitor it for radiation – which can be a very demanding and time consuming job. These things are all done without any complaints from her whatsoever, and they are in addition to her

actual duties of office manager and weighmaster, which she does equally well at the same time. With Mat out sick Amy is the only real point of contact at White Pines. The drilling companies are coming in hot and heavy and this will continue for a very long time. On Monday we were faced with a situation of too many customers coming in on one day. We have a daily limit of 1,000 tons per day at White Pines. We cannot exceed that amount under any circumstances. Amy was fully aware of this. She had a list of every customer she expected for the day as well as how many loads they were going to bring in. It was clear there would not be room. She is in contact with all the drilling companies and was able to control what they brought in. I deal with all the scale masters at our landfills and A&M. I am truly impressed with Amy. She is a very valuable employee. With Mat out sick it is nice to know we have such a conscientious and knowledgeable employee at White Pines.


